Protection of Canadian property in China.
Refer to Foreign Office letter of 3rd June (F 5785/62/10). Enclose copy of despatch No. 149 from Ottawa of 29th June stating that information has been received that the Cathedral erected by the Church of England in Canada at Kaifeng has been seriously damaged by Japanese aerial bombs, and that the Canadian Government are considering advisability of approaching Japanese Government with a claim for damages, and requesting information as to action taken or contemplated by His Majesty's Government in connexion with similar injuries to British property.
